

Note from Ms. Powell

SLCSE Families,

Dr. Angela Dunn has issued a public health order requiring people in Salt Lake County, regardless of vaccination status or past COVID-19 infection, to wear well-fitting masks when indoors. Since the Salt Lake school district has required masking throughout the school year, we anticipate minimal impact from the ordinance.

However, for optimal protection, Dr. Dunn recommends wearing respirators, such as KN95s, instead of cloth masks, if possible. The county is offering respirators free of charge to the public at senior centers and county library branches; however, the county asks that only those who do not have the means to purchase a respirator on their own take advantage of the free, public supply.

We will also have a limited supply of respirators at school for students. Alternatively, if you are unable to acquire a respirator for your student, double masking with a medical mask and cloth covering also offers extra protection.

It is critical that we remain vigilant in our efforts to keep our students and staff healthy. Please remind your student that proper mask wearing shows that they care about others and are doing their part to keep students, teachers, and staff healthy. Please keep your student at home if they are sick. Teachers are posting work on Canvas every day so that students at home can access their assignments.





Virtual Open House January 20 @6pm

10th Grade Field Trip to the Utah Museum of Natural History




**11th graders agreed
