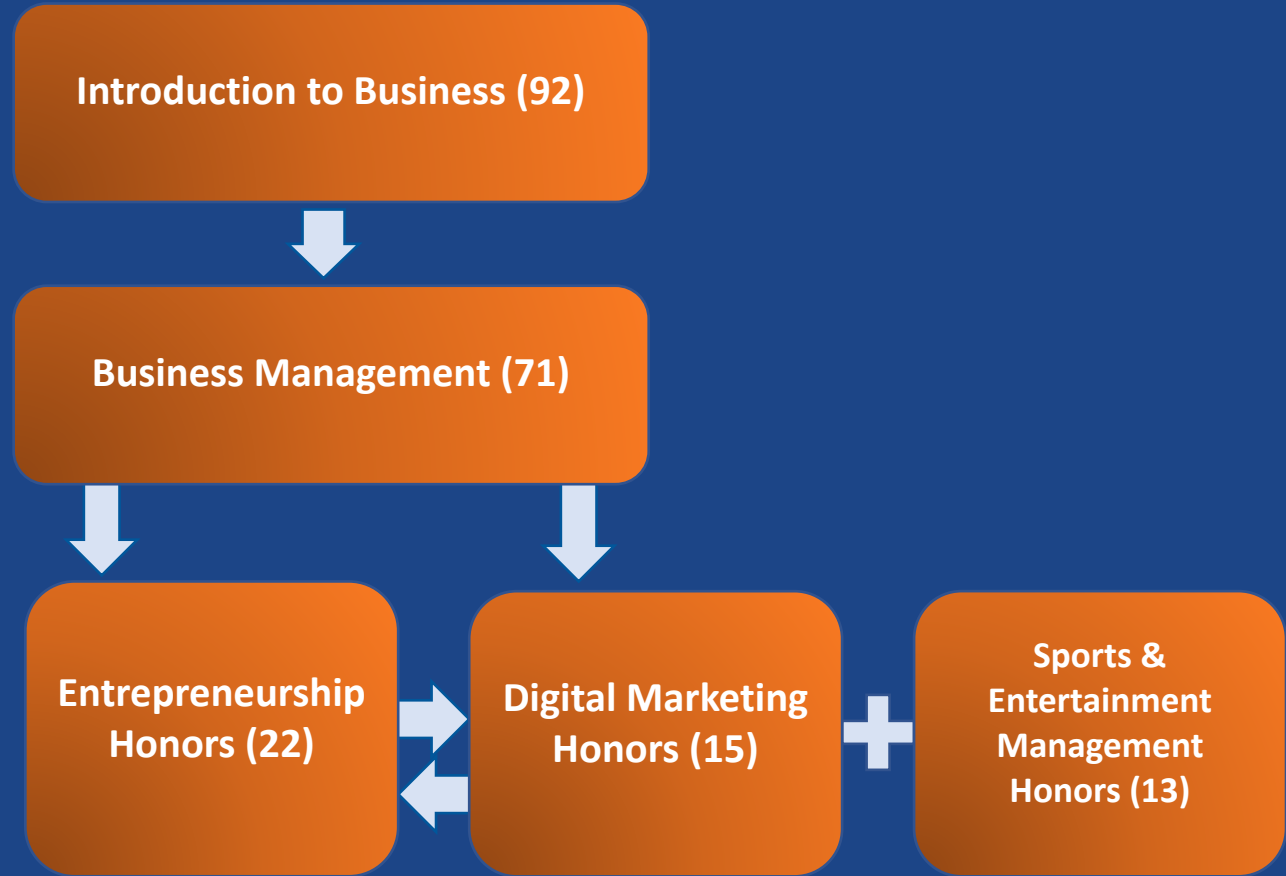

- “sharpen college-level research, writing, collaboration, and presentation skills at an advanced level.”
- 58% of sophomores demonstrated interest in enrolling for ‘23-’24
- AP Research Capstone not required

- Art Portfolio Development to receive honors credit
  - Music Theory I removed from program (2017-2018)
  - Prerequisite language revised to “Department Recommendation”
  - Special Services course descriptions added
