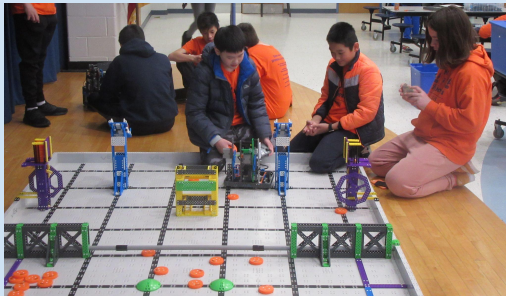

Robotics Club

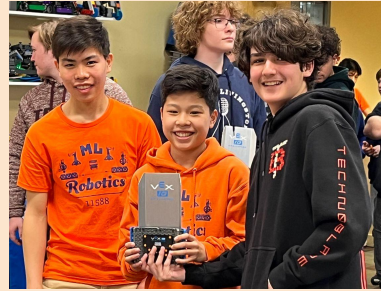
- 50 Students (16 teams)

Students participated in The Doodle For Google.

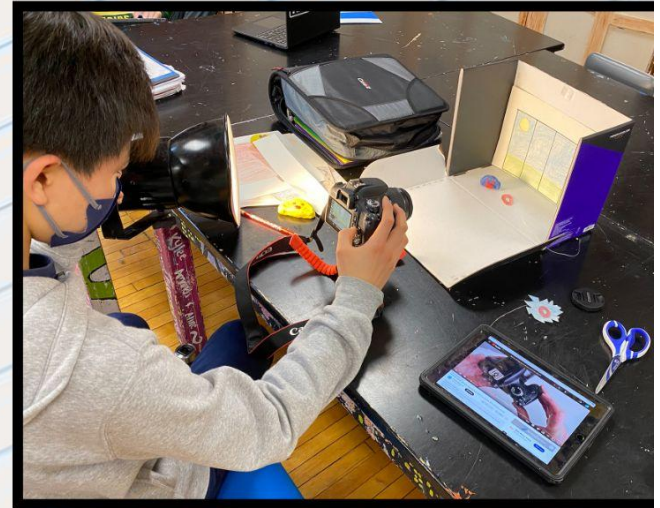
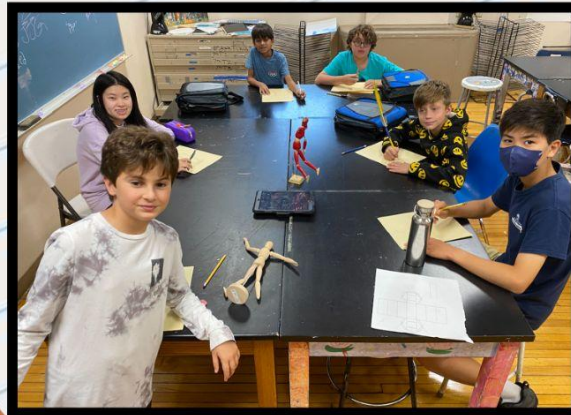
Created the cover design for the 2023-2024 Agenda Cover.
