

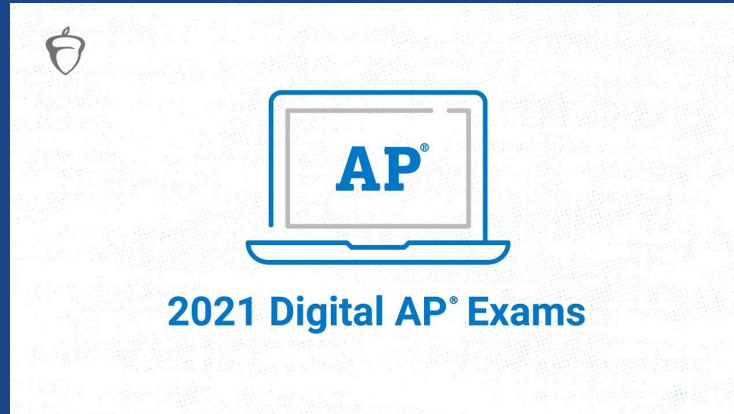

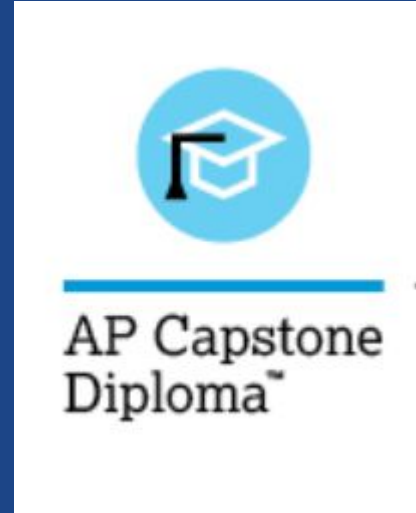

# Factors That Impact AP Registration

- May not get college credit
- Desire to take the class again in college
- Those taking multiple AP courses may not be able to prepare for all exams
- Belief that AP exam performance does not have a tremendous impact on collegiate admissions
- Feeling unprepared / will not earn a 4 or 5
- Belief they are a poor standardized test taker / test anxiety
- Want to enjoy end of senior year
- Cost

- AP Scholar: 42 students
- AP Scholar with Honor: 22 students
- AP Scholar with Distinction: 78 students
- AP Capstone Diploma: 26 students
- AP Seminar & Research Certificate: 9 students
