School Safety and Security



As a Community...

- Keeping our eyes and ears open for anything out of the ordinary or for anything suspicious.
- Continuing to abide by our School Visitor Protocol.
- Reporting anything suspicious to the Administration or our School Resource Officer.
- Teaching our students to avoid "going through the motions" during our security drills and demand vigilant and proper behavior from our students and staff members.
- Encouraging students to report any threats posted on social media or any suspicious behavior.
- Sharing feedback with each other on a regular basis to improve protocol and procedures.
- Addressing the needs of our students to help them cope with stress and anxiety.

Safety and Security Measures

- Emergency Management Plan - Our crisis management plan serves as an operating guide for a wide range of emergencies. It is developed in coordination with local police, fire, and emergency agencies.
- Security Cameras – Multiple cameras are installed throughout our buildings, grounds, and busses.
- School Resource Officer – We have a MLPD Officer in our buildings during the instructional school day to ensure safety and respond to emergent situations.

Safety and Security Measures

- Security Drills – Each month we run both fire and emergency drills to provide students and staff with an opportunity to practice emergency protocol.
- School Safety Specialist:
 - Responsible for the supervision and oversight for all school safety and security personnel, policies, and procedures in the school district;
 - ensure that these policies are in compliance with state law and regulations;
 - and provide the necessary training and resources to district staff in matters relating to school safety and security.
 - The SSS will also serve as the district's liaison with local law enforcement, as well as national, state and community agencies and organizations, in matters of school safety and security.
