

ARTICLE III: SELECTION OF MEMBERS

Section 1. The selection of members to this chapter shall be by a majority vote of the Faculty Council consisting of five faculty members appointed by the Principal or Adviser. The chapter Adviser shall be the sixth, non-voting, ex-officio member of the Faculty Council.

Section 2. Prior to selection, the following shall occur:

- a. Students' academic records shall be reviewed to determine scholastic eligibility.
- b. Students who are eligible scholastically ("candidates") shall be notified and asked to complete and submit the New Member Application Form for further consideration for selection.
- c. The New Membership Application Forms shall be submitted to the chapter Adviser by a stated deadline. No late forms shall be accepted.
- d. The chapter Adviser shall be requested to evaluate candidates determined to be scholastically eligible after being given the list of students under consideration and then contacting the chapter officers. The chapter Adviser & officers shall review the New Member Application Form and faculty evaluations to determine membership.
- e. A candidate shall be eliminated from consideration for Alpha Titan membership if their records contain any of the following: current documented disciplinary infractions; documented disciplinary infractions that occurred in the previous two full semesters; "Out of School Suspension/s" during his/her current or previous high school years; "In School Suspension/s" for more than one incident during current or previous high school years.
- f. The selection of members to the chapter shall be by a majority vote of the faculty council.

Section 3. The selection of new, active members shall be held once a year. The selection of juniors will occur during the first quarter of the school year.

Section 4. Candidates become members when inducted at a ceremony.

Section 5. An active member of the National Honor Society who transfers from this school will be given a letter indicating the status of his/her membership and signed by the Principal and Adviser.

Section 6. An active member of the National Honor Society who transfers to this school will be *automatically* accepted for membership in this chapter. The Faculty Council shall grant to the transferring member one quarter to attain the membership requirements and, thereafter, this member must maintain those requirements for this chapter to retain his/her membership.
