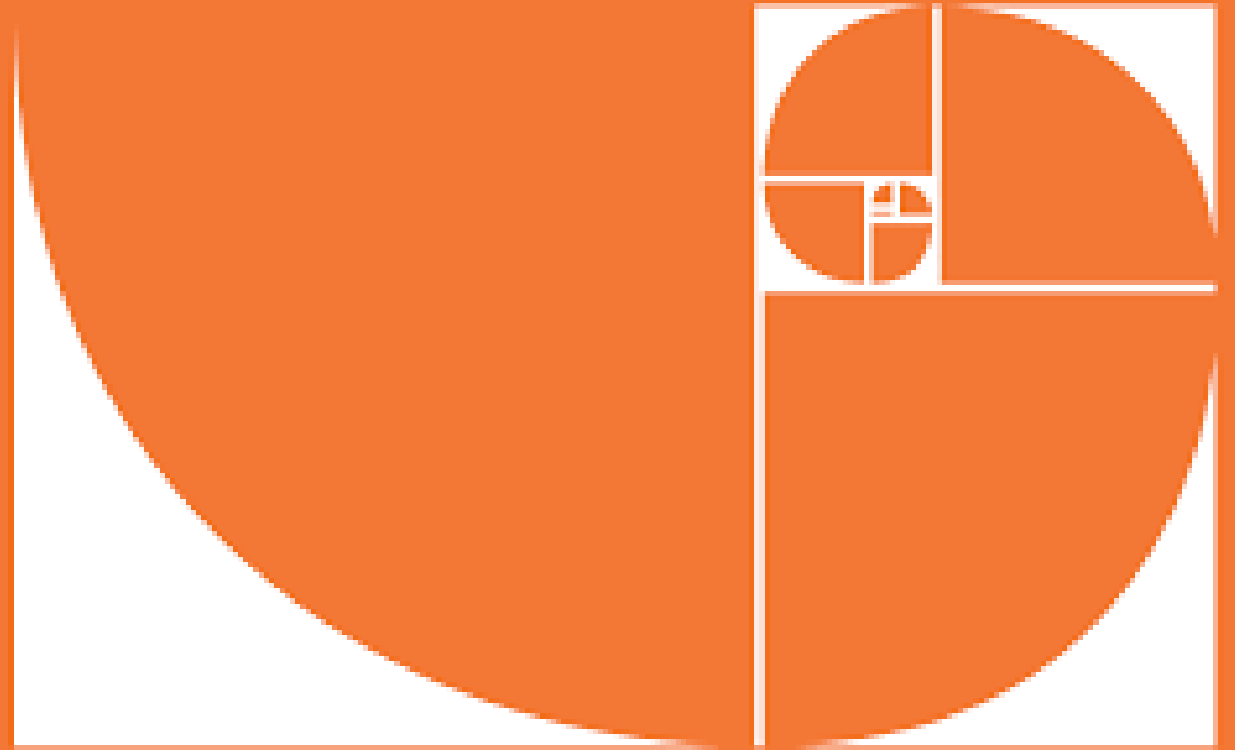

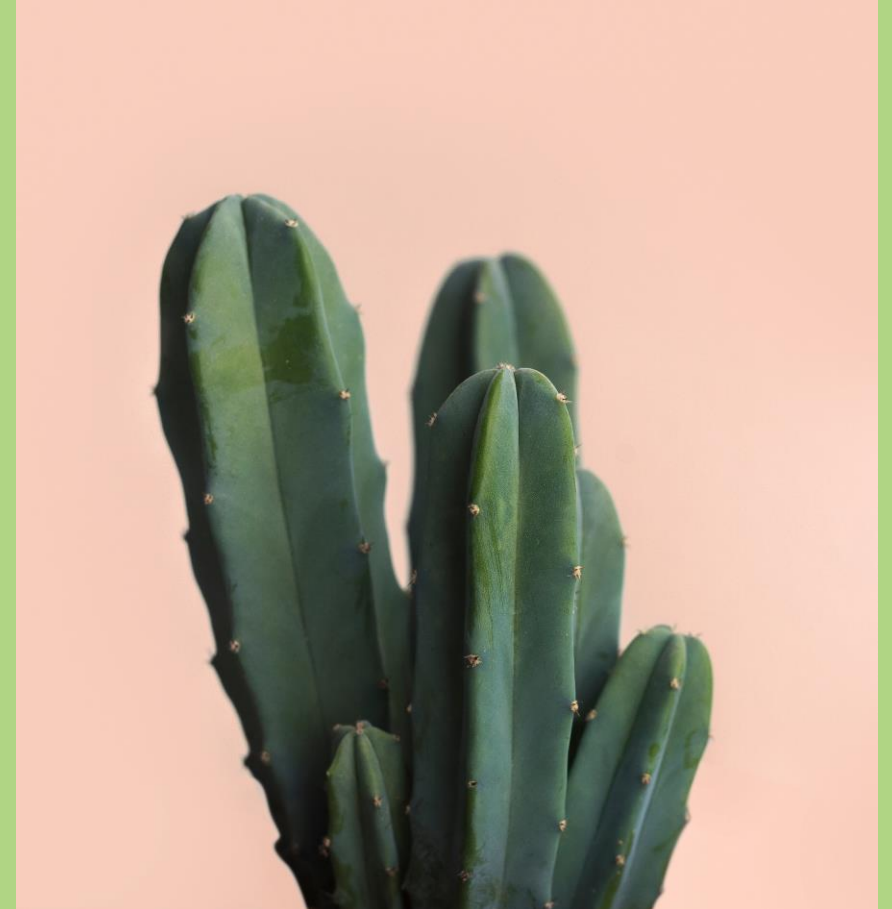

WELCOMING OUR NEW TEACHERS MR. MOWER
