

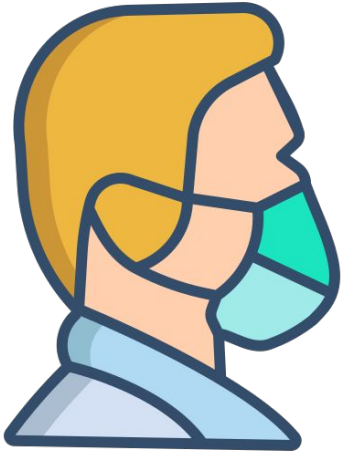

MLSD Covid Cases

- **Vaccinations** underway for staff and *students (12* to 18 years old)*.
 - **COVID Testing** - mobile lab at MLHS every Wednesday from 1PM-3PM, effective April 14 thru end of school year:
 - Open to community
 - Only asymptomatic (PCR) testing; results within 24-48 hours

New Jersey School Guidelines Remain

- Face masks remain mandatory in schools for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year.
 - All students will be back in school for full-time, in-person instruction for the start of the 2021-2022 school year. Full-time remote learning will not be an option for most families.
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QSAC Update

- The Mountain Lakes QSAC team met with county officials to review our QSAC submission on Tuesday, May 4th.
 - Preliminary scoring shared by the county indicate our continued status as a “High Performing District” by the NJDOE.
 - Our finalized scores will be shared upon receipt from the state. We anticipate these scores within the next few weeks.
