

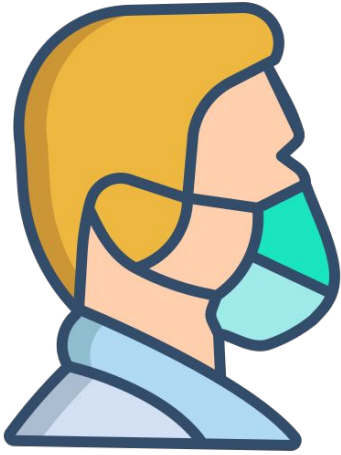

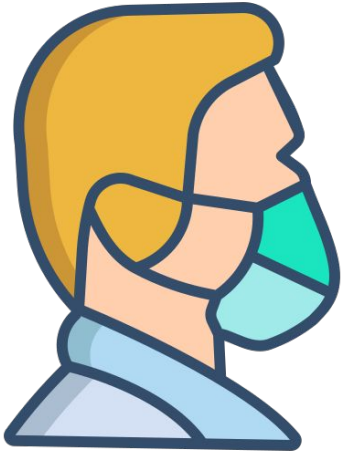


MLSD Covid Cases

Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) Update





QSAC Update

- **Updated State Law:** On December 23, 2020, Governor Murphy signed A-4975 into law (P.L.2020, c.143), which provides for postponement of New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) review for certain school districts that are scheduled to undergo a NJQSAC comprehensive review in the 2020-2021 school year.
 - **Potential Requests:** The law also allows these districts to request to undergo a comprehensive NJQSAC monitoring in the 2020-2021 school year, as originally scheduled.
 - **Our Position:** The Mountain Lakes School District will be submitting a request to the state to undergo a comprehensive NJQSAC monitoring to ensure our practices and processes meet state expectations.
