Administration

Management Oversight

The New London Board of Education is responsible for overseeing management of the school district's major systems, which include, but are not limited to:

- Educational Programming
- Finance/Budget
- Talent/Human Resources
- Construction Management/Facilities Maintenance
- Transportation
- Food services
- Information Technology
- Safety & Security

The Superintendent will be responsible for ensuring that all procedures, controls, checks and balances, and codes of ethics are in place and are being executed properly.

The Board will hold the Superintendent accountable for the performance of these district business systems. In exercising its oversight responsibilities, the Board will not interfere with the Superintendent's management in the district.

The Board, acting as a body, will require the Superintendent to provide data and other information necessary to document effective execution and results. The Board may also decide to call for external reviews of systems' integrity and performance (e.g., from audit firms, task forces comprised of local experts or community members, etc.)
