Gifts of Library Materials

The Board of Education welcomes gifts of books, magazines, news clippings and other materials intended for use in school library media centers and in public school classrooms. It is understood that items donated for use will be evaluated by professional school system staff and will be added to collections after examination and appraisal concerning the items factual nature, its relevance to the curriculum, its quality, and its overall merit. Items donated to the school system can be evaluated and can be discarded. Such items become the property of the school system and materials can be weeded just as are materials purchased for use. The Board of Education reserves the right to decline acceptance of donated materials.
