- PS 17 Presentational Writing Demonstrates understanding of appropriate grammar, spelling and syntax for the intermediate high level in a variety of time frames.
- PS 18 Presentational Writing Writes with high degree of accuracy on familiar topics using well-practiced language with additional resources such as dictionaries, peer-edits, and notes.
