Standard Based Grading

The student gradebook is set in Standards Based Grading form. Skyward will represent the learning skills listed instead of the names of individual events. The grades entered into the grade book will no longer be based on points, but will use the following Grading Scale.

No Evidence (0)	Beginning (1)	Progressing (2)	Proficient (3)	Exceptional (4)
Student has not submitted or produced evidence of understanding/application of skill.	Unable to demonstrate understanding or show application of skill without support or evidence is not complete.	Inconsistently or partially demonstrates understanding or shows application of skill.	Consistently demonstrates complete and consistent understanding/application of skill or concept.	Demonstrates complete understanding/application of skill or concept <u>and</u> deeper learning of concepts or skills beyond the level explicitly taught.

Essentially, each Subject will use the “mode” of what you get on each skill to determine your final grade that Subject. For example, for Subject 2 if Sam achieves a **4** on skill 1, a **4** on skill 2, a **4** on skill 3 and a **3** on skill 4. The final achieved grade will = **4**.

However, a student may not have a **2** or less on ANY skill OR ASSESSMENT TO RECEIVE A **4** for that Subject.

Student’s may redo a non lab event if the grade does not reflect their knowledge of the material. The student must contact the instructor for the redo assessment(s):

A student overall/class grade will then be based on the mode (what grade is earned the most often) of the Subjects. A student CANNOT receive an A for the class if they have a C or lower for ANY Subject.

Here is how the 1,2,3,4 will translate to a traditional letter grade:

PERFORMANCE LEVEL OVERALL SCORE	LETTER GRADE ASSIGNED
3.0 - 4.0	A
2.5 - 2.99	B
2.0 - 2.49	C
1.0 - 1.99	D
0 - 1.0	F
