Tell that person about one of the characters.	Would you rather learn at home or at school? Be sure to include a topic sentence, two reasons, and a conclusion.	Make a list of living and non-living things in your home.

Write three facts about an animal. (Where does it live? What does it eat? How does it move? Can it be a pet? etc.)	Make a list of how you can be respectful, responsible, and safe at home.
Play a board game or put together a puzzle.	Read to a stuffed or real animal. Practice reading like you are telling a story!	Explain why is it important to eat healthy foods and make a list of your favorite healthy foods.	Record the weather for today. Include the temperature, rain/snow, what the sky looks like (sunny, cloudy).
I got 10 pieces of fruit at the store. Some are apples and some are oranges. Show all the combinations of apples and oranges I could have gotten that equal 10.	Find a dark place to read (a closet or a fort with blankets) and read using a flashlight.	Write about how to make your own breakfast. Be sure to use words like first, next, then, and last.	Make a list of things that make loud noises. Make another list of things that make soft noises.
