Make sure to use complete sentences with capitals and punctuation. Write 5-7 sentences including details about your activities. Search around your house and include 5-7 in each category.
Measure 6 things around your home. Order them from shortest to longest.	Go on Epic and read one book to yourself and have one book read to you.	Draw a picture and write a story to go with it. Think about beginning, middle, and end. Challenge: Use transition words (first, next, then, etc.)!	Create your own weather journal at home using notebook paper. What does it look like outside? What does it feel like? Use descriptive words to describe what you see and feel. Keep this going each morning.	Play BANG for 10 minutes. Then pick 5 cards and write a sentence for each.
Count Legos. Count the blocks. Then try counting the pegs that stick out of each Lego. Do groups help here? How can you organize and write down this count? What if a 4 block peg was 1? How much would each of your pieces be worth?	Read to yourself or to someone else for 20 minutes. Summarize what you read to someone.	Practice writing your full name in your best handwriting. Pick a few family members and write their names.	Build a structure using materials you can find around your house.	Make a t-chart of long and short vowels. Look through your books at home and write at least 10 words in each category.
Go to IXL and choose a skill to practice for 20 minutes.	Read a book and write a review. Do you recommend this book? Who do you recommend it to? How many stars would you give it out of 1-5? What was your favorite part?	Write a letter to your teacher and try to persuade her to get a classroom pet.	Draw and label a picture of the water cycle.	Practice your sight words at home. You can triangle spell, rainbow write, write each word 3 times, make sound boxes, etc.
