We are a highly competitive sport and it is our aim to get all shooters out at competitions up and down the country, irrespective of how long they have been clay shooting.

THE PROGRAMME

Clay shooting is an all year games option offering comprehensive training and competitive opportunities throughout each term. Although we have a large number of shooters, individual squad sizes are kept small to maximise the effectiveness of the coaching experience. We have eight regular coaches provided by our home venue, Mendip Shooting Ground. Squads are set by skill level and we aim to maintain some consistency within the staff allocated to each. The Head Coach Alex Hill, in conjunction with Head of Shooting Sally Bishop and captains Dominic Simmons and Tallula Taylor, will regularly observe all the squads to determine specific coaching requirements and squad composition. We live shoot twice a week on Wednesdays and Saturdays and have a gym training session on a Thursday for selected students to enhance overall fitness and core strength. In addition to training at our home ground we regularly travel to external venues to experience different layouts and terrain. Students also benefit from experiencing a simulated game shoot day which has proven invaluable to improve reaction time and versatility.
