FINANCES

We take our role as stewards of your taxpayer dollars very seriously and are committed to transparency. We are in good financial health with a balanced budget, high credit rating, low interest rates, secure savings, and strong bond capacity.

We're pleased to share that we have been able to:

* Decrease the tax rate for the fourth year in a row.

- Upgrade our credit rating. We are now in the top 8% of schools in the state.
- Make enhancements in our efforts to ensure competitive salaries for educators and support staff.
- Avoid increased costs through benefit plan management.

Referendum dollars continue to critically support financial needs through funding for safety, mental health and teacher compensation. The current operating referendum is set to expire at the end of 2026. Expect to hear more in coming years as decisions regarding next steps for the referendum are made.



CHALLENGES

STAFFING – teacher and labor shortages have made staffing our schools increasingly more challenging.

COMPENSATION – The best teachers and staff mean the best education experience for students. We will continue to focus on investing in competitive pay to attract and retain strong employees.

FALSE INFORMATION – The spread of false school information through rumors and misinformation, especially on social media, continues to be a challenge. We encourage the public to utilize our communication channels for factual information or contact us directly with questions.



THE NEW BEAVER STADIUM

has increased seating, lighting, parking, concessions, training space, and storage and is used for football, track, band and district events. Beaver Materials purchased the naming rights for the stadium.

CONSTRUCTION

We have experienced significant growth in certain areas over the last several years and are addressing over-capacity facilities with expansion and renovation projects.

Recent projects include a new classroom wing at Noble Crossing Elementary, and new cafeteria, gym, and music spaces at North Elementary. We also renovated the NHS gym "The Mill", dedicated additional tennis courts, and completed the first new Noblesville stadium in over 50 years. Additional expansion/renovation projects are currently underway at Promise Road Elementary, Noblesville High School, and the high school baseball facility near Hazel Dell Elementary.

Please note, these projects are funded through bonds (loans) with no use of referendum or classroom dollars, and no increase to the tax rate.
