ABOUT DESTINATION IMAGINATION



- 2 to 7 members can be on a team.
- Students from 2nd through University participate.
- Each team needs at least **ONE ADULT** team manager.
- Team Managers help students stay on track but **DO NOT DIRECTLY HELP** the team develop its solution to the Destination Imagination challenge.
- Team Managers are often teachers, parents, brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles or grandparents, **ANY ADULT OLDER THAN 18.**
