

506 Form FAQS:

What is a 506 form?

This form serves as the official record of the eligibility determination for each individual child included in the student count for the Title VI Indian Education Formula Grant Program.

2

Is my child eligible?

If your student is a member of a Tribe or Band, or a descendant, in the first or second degree, they are eligible.

3

Why should I fill the 506 form out?

Title VI Indian Education Formula Grant Program ensures the school district is providing quality education for Native students as required by tribal treaties. Every form increases funding for the program, and helps students get academic support & cultural programming.

4

Must I have their enrollment number available?

Yes, in order for the form to be considered "complete" we need Proof of Membership. This can be an enrollment number OR other evidence establishing membership.
