IV. Superintendent Report

A. Updates

Dr. Maria Rianna acknowledged two alumni (Frank Venturino and Bob Marino) in the audience that presented the district with a \$3,500 check with monies raised to donate buddy benches to the district. Dr. Rianna also acknowledged High School Principal Allen Hudson who meets with the alumni when they come for events, and gives them a tour of the school. Mr. Marino said a few words about the reunion they had in May as well as a fantastic and memorable tour by Mr. Hudson. The district thanked them.

Dr. Rianna continued by sharing information on an incident that took place on the high school field over a week ago. She stated that she debriefed with EMS, the Glen Cove Fire Department and the Glen Cove Police Department where they reviewed safety procedures. As a result of the meeting, it was acknowledged that even if the phone reception is bad, 911 calls go through overriding any carrier. It was also thought that time would be lost by calling 911 as it's directed to Nassau County and then re-directed to Glen Cove, however the Superintendent found out that both EMS and the fire department are made aware of any emergency. Dr. Rianna thanked the Board of Education for approving having a consultant come in over the summer to enhance our Wi-Fi and cell use across the district and this will continue to be enhanced. Safety concerns were brought to our attention and as a result the back high school gate will continue to be closed however security personnel will be positioned at the back gate with a radio in the event an emergency situation should arise after school hours and that they will be notified immediately. Dr. Rianna additionally mentioned that all three emergency departments stated that a gate will not stop them from getting to where they need to go. Additionally, it was mentioned that even if the back gate had been opened during this incident that emergency personnel would have had to cross the fields to get to the student in need. The Superintendent of Schools stated to the community that if you are not on the high school campus for a particular purpose, that cutting through or riding through is not appropriate and said that the community has been great about it. We continue to work with our emergency services to ensure that our procedures are where they need to be. We will continue to have regular routine conversations so that we are current with all of these departments. We are looking into other safety options that were brought up and as they become available Dr. Rianna will keep both the Board of Education and the community informed.

The Superintendent of Schools has also visited classrooms across the district and it has been wonderful seeing the kid's enthusiasm and back in the swing of school. She thanked the staff that continues to move this district forward day after day. Our administrative staff has been wonderful communicating with each other and really enhancing what both Mr. Venturino and Mr. Marino were talking about, "The Love of our District". Dr Rianna is looking forward to spirit week as well as a number of events coming together as a district. The Superintendent also thanked the PTA as they work with the principals and our teachers to make this a more enjoyable school year.
