

How to Ride the METRO

GUIDE FOR ELEMENTARY & MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS AND THEIR PARENT/GUARDIAN

Elementary and middle school students may board a metro bus to and from school on the day their bus is canceled. Elementary school students may only board if accompanied by an adult. No fare or i.d. required at this time.



Arrive Early

Get to the bus stop a few minutes early to avoid missing the bus.



Introduce Yourself

Tell the bus driver that you are traveling to school by bus today because the yellow bus was cancelled. Identify the school and find a seat.



No Bus Fare Necessary

Bus fares are waived for students through a partnership between Portland Public Schools and METRO. An adult companion may also ride for free with each elementary school student.



Pull the Yellow Cord

Pull the cord before your stop so the bus operator has time to stop safely.



Be Safe

Do not run after a bus or walk in front of the bus. Wait for the bus to leave before crossing the street.
