

PROMOTION POLICY

The State of Hawaii Board of Education approved Statute #4502, Middle-Level Education Promotion, on August 5, 2010.

“The Board of Education recognizes that young adolescence is a critical period in the development and education of students. Middle-level students must develop 21st-century learning skills and be able to use technological tools. Therefore, all students in grades six, seven, and eight shall be required to take language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies and be able to demonstrate their 21st-century knowledge and skills.”

“Students will receive an academic unit for each core content course to be promoted to the next level. Successful completion shall be based on academic proficiency of identified benchmarks.”

The Lahaina Intermediate School Promotion Policy reflects the State’s Middle-Level Education Promotion Policy:

**Grade 6: Students must successfully complete (4) core subject units
(English, Math, Science, Social Studies)**

**Grade 7: Students must successfully complete (4) core subject units
(English, Math, Science, Social Studies)**

**Grade 8: Students must successfully complete (4) core subject units
(English, Math, Science, Social Studies)**
