DISTRICT DRESS CODE

Handling Infractions

The Dress Code Policy is adopted by the Board of Education with the understanding that infractions will be handled in a sensitive and fair manner, fully realizing that students in the Salinas City Elementary School District come to school with diverse backgrounds and cultures.

It is understood that before the procedure is implemented, the parent/guardian and student will be informed of the Dress Code Policy.

1. When an infraction is first observed the student should be reminded of the District Dress Code by the Teacher or Principal. Additionally, the Principal may call the parent/guardian if he/she feels a call is warranted.
2. In the event of a second infraction, the Principal may send the student home for correction or call the parent/guardian and indicate what corrective steps should be taken.
3. If the student returns to school, after appropriate notification of the parent/guardian, but has not complied with the requirements for corrective action, a written notice may be sent to the parent/guardian by First Class Mail, advising the need to take action to comply with Board Policy #5132 and inviting the parent/guardian to discuss the issue with the Principal if there are questions to be resolved.
4. If the parent/guardian does not make contact and the student still has not complied, appropriate disciplinary action should be taken.
5. If compliance is not secured by the above measures, the parent/guardian may be referred to the Superintendent and/or the Board of Education for further action up to and including suspension from school.
