## SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION

Mandated Policy

The Governing Board shall provide supplemental instructional programs to motivate and support students to overcome academic deficiencies, attain grade-level academic standards, or enhance critical skills.

Supplemental instructional programs shall be offered outside the regular school day. Such programs may be offered during the summer, before school, after school, on Saturday and/or during intersessions. (Education Code 37252, 37252.5, 37252.6, 37253)

The Board shall offer direct, systematic and intensive supplemental instruction for students in grades 2 through 6 who have been retained or recommended for retention pursuant to Education Code 48070.5. (Education Code 37252.5)

As funding, facilities and staffing permit, supplemental instruction may be offered to:

1. Students in grades 2 through 6 who have been identified as being at risk of retention pursuant to Education Code 48070.5 (Education Code 37252.5)
2. Students in grades 2 through 6 who have been identified as having a deficiency in mathematics, reading or written expression based on the results of the Standardized Testing and Reporting Program (Education Code 37252.6)
3. Students in grades kindergarten through 6 who seek enrichment in mathematics, science or other core academic areas designated by the Superintendent of Public Instruction (Education Code 37253; 5 CCR 11472)
4. Students in grades kindergarten through 4 who need or desire intensive reading opportunities that meet the standards specified in Education Code 44259 and 53027 for a research-based comprehensive reading program (Education Code 53025-53031)
5. Students in grades kindergarten through 6, including English language learners, who need or desire intensive English language and literacy instruction (Education Code 422-424)

The programs described in items #4 through #6 above shall be offered during summer school except when facilities constraints or other educational reasons make it not feasible to offer these programs during summer school, in which case they may be offered before school, after school, on Saturday and/or during intersessions. (Education Code 423, 53029, 53083)
