Bylaw #9110

TERMS OF OFFICE

The Governing Board of the Salinas City Elementary School District shall consist of five members elected from five trustee areas whose terms shall be staggered so that as nearly as practicable, one half of the members shall be elected in each odd-numbered year. The five trustee areas are:

Trustee Area #1	Elected in 2001
Trustee Area #2	Elected in 1999
Trustee Area #3	Elected in 2001
Trustee Area #4	Elected in 1999
Trustee Area #5	Elected in 2001

Said members shall be elected from their respective trustee areas by voters of the respective trustee areas on dates specified in state law.

The term of office for members elected in regular elections shall be four years, commencing on the first Friday in December next succeeding their election. (Education Code 5017)

Board member terms expire four years after their initial election on the first Friday in December following the election of new members. (Education Code 5000)

A member whose term has expired shall continue to discharge the duties of the office until his/her successor has qualified by taking the oath of office. (Government Code 1302, 1360; Education Code 5017)
