Student voice is an integral component of our school board. The Board appreciates their reports, opinions, and advisory votes.

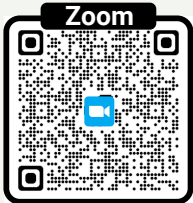

Board Workshops:

- First monthly meeting, typically held on the 2nd Wednesday at 6:30pm.
- No action taken.
- Discussion on agenda topics.
- Conversations with community on agenda topics.

Business Meetings:

- Second monthly meeting, typically held on the 4th Wednesday of the month at 6:30pm.
- Action taken on the Consent Agenda and New Business.
- Board Meeting in Public.
- Public can provide 5 minute comments on any topic.
- Board does not respond to public comments at this meeting.

Board Retreats:

- Twice a year, typically in January and August.
- Open to the public in person.

Special Business Meetings:

- Added to a workshop when action needs to be taken on a business item.
- Timing is usually of the essence.
- Board meeting in public.

Executive Sessions:

- Specific Purpose RCW 42.30.110.
- Closed to the public.
- Publicly announced in Business Meeting.
