The use of funds via the student wellness and disadvantaged pupil impact aide supplied by the Department of Education and Workforce (DEW) permits Allen East to offer the students and families of Allen East comprehensive services to ensure the health and mental wellbeing of our students. Allen East is able to employ two full-time social workers, one full-time nurse and one full-time school counselor with the funds. Furthermore, with the funds, Allen East is able to offer a tutoring program for students who are at-risk of not passing the state mandated assessments. Lastly, Allen East has a comprehensive drug testing program for students who participate in extracurricular activities. The drug testing regimen is non-punitive and is in place to prevent students from using drugs in the first place, and to get students help who test positive for drugs.

Allen East partners with SAFY (Mental Health & Recovery Board) and PASS also known as Prevention Awareness Support Services to provide mental health services to the children of Allen East. SAFY is a comprehensive mental health program located in the Lima, Ohio region that provides family support, counseling and mental health services to Allen East. PASS is used by Allen East in emergency situations to provide mental health services to the community, Allen East families, Allen East staff and most importantly Allen East children in times of emergencies. Allen East is a long-time partner with SAFY and PASS.
