Each large elementary school (400 FTE students) can assign eight (8) stipends.


Each regular elementary school can assign six (6) stipends.

Stipends on this schedule may include a variety of responsibilities, such as:

- Leading grade level or department meetings
- Participating in building leadership meetings with administration
- Serving as teacher-administration liaison in the site-based decision-making process
- Attending district level grade level/content area meetings
- Managing departmental budget and inventory
- Aligning grade level/content areas grading and assessment practices

This agreement shall be in effect for the 2023-24 school year.
