

Science National Honor Society Bylaws

To Qualify for Membership:

1. A member must be a junior or a senior at PHS.
2. A member must have and maintain an overall 3.5/4.0 grade point average.
3. A member must have and maintain a 3.5/4.0 average across all science classes.
4. At the time of application, a member must be enrolled in at least one honors or AP science class.
5. A member must be enrolled in at least one AP science class during or prior to the twelfth grade year.

To be Inducted and/or Maintain Membership:

7. A member must maintain behavior that is acceptable to the guidelines of their educational institution.
8. A member must have no lower than a C for any science class for a semester 1 and quarter 3 grade. If a member has lower than a C for a semester grade, they have until the end of quarter 3 to improve.
9. A member must perform ten hours of school/community service in approved service projects. ***Five hours are required to be performed within the society and the remaining service hours can be from outside of the club (a maximum of 3 hours from the summer).
10. Members will fill out a google form to submit service hours. Members can view their service hour progress throughout the year using a document posted to the club's Google Classroom.
10. A junior member must re-apply in the fall of their senior year to verify GPA and enrolled courses required to maintain membership.
11. An honor cord will be awarded only to students who have maintained membership throughout their senior year. Therefore grades, AP level class enrollment, and service hours meet requirements.
12. Induction will be jointly held with Mu Alpha Theta in May.
