PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Conducts preventive maintenance inspections; determines what equipment is broken or operating inefficiently.
- 2. Repairs or replaces a variety of fixtures and equipment such as lights, electric motors, furnaces, stoves, kilns, washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, water coolers and ice machines.
- 3. Installs structures and fixtures
- 4. Measures, cuts or shapes wood, plastic and other materials
- 5. Constructs, and helps erect, level, install and inspect building frameworks
- 6. Operate machinery to break up concrete
