WELCOME

The new 105,353 square-foot Nottingham Elementary provides unparalleled classroom views and functionality through its collaborative learning spaces, enhanced library and learning courtyard.

The replacement school is a significant upgrade from the original 66,393 square-foot building constructed in 1969 and accommodates 750 students.



BUILDING

The school's design was a collaboration between Spring Branch ISD, PBK and the Project Advisory Team, composed of staff, parents and community members. Durotech, Inc. served as the Construction Manager at Risk for the project. All classrooms receive natural light and are equipped with flexible student and teacher furniture, a large active wall, an electronic active panel and plenty of storage.



COMMUNITY AND NATURE



The school's design is integrated into the surrounding community and embraces nature, similar to the original building. Large classroom windows, hallways and open learning spaces allow students and staff to appreciate the beauty of the trees, foliage and the outdoors. The Learning Courtyard even includes an outdoor classroom, providing an immersive learning space.





At the heart of the school is a spacious library, around which two classroom wings are built. Additionally, several collaborative areas with flexible furniture are available to extend learning beyond the classrooms, catering to both individual and multi-class use.





THE SITE PLAN

School grounds boast an outdoor covered play area, a large open field with walking track, outdoor play and exercise equipment for all age groups and a dedicated small playground for younger children. There are three overhead doors between the school's cafeteria and gymnasium that are designed for the two spaces to become one large, contiguous space when opened.
