Board Members Present: John Hctor, Deborah Heart, Betty Richards, and Darren Hoffman. Beth Schroder was absent.
Others Present: Lori Hackbarth-Executive Assistant, Dean Schlenker-Business Manager and Steven Randall-Director of Maintenance.

Ms. Heart, Board Chair called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Tour of Facilities: The school board members, Mr. Grabenhorst. Mr. Schlenker and Mr. Randall took a tour of all three school buildings. An overview of summer projects was provided.

Worksession Discussion: Mr. Grabenhorst asked the Board members to consider two to three goals for him for this school year. Administrator evaluations will be conducted by him for the three principals; the Board members will consider goals they would like to see for the building principals and share with Mr. Grabenhorst. Mr. Westerman will conduct the evaluation for Ms. Hedges and will soon attend a training to become more familiar with the eVal process and procedures. At the September Board Meeting, an executive session will be held to review the performance of a public employee.

The administrative team will review the Title I, Parent Engagement policy to ensure it is prepared for a second reading and adoption at the September school board meeting. Mr. Grabenhorst will review all current board policies to ensure Essential policies are updated and any missing policies are prepared for adoption.

The Board members discussed a boys soccer program for the high school. The Board members had earlier agreed to analyze all athletic programs for participation levels and budget constraints in light of the 1.1 million-dollar levy funding loss that is coming to the school district next year.

Mr. Grabenhorst noted that the Goldendale Way recordings will continue as this is a great opportunity to have our students share information about programs in their schools. Student Representatives on the school board will be selected after the school year is underway through the high school Leadership class. Any requests from the public for information/presentations to school board members will be directed to Mr. Grabenhorst or the affected principal.

Mr. Grabenhorst will review the current special education programs and see what improvements might be made to enhance services. He will meet with the county treasurer and assessor soon to discuss funding for our county and school district.

Adjournment: There being no further discussion, the work session was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
