

North Kansas City Schools Z-Pass Student Ridership Program

North Kansas City Schools uses Z-Pass Student Ridership technology for elementary students who ride District buses to and from school. The Z-Pass allows the District to monitor students getting on and off the bus to ensure student safety. The Z-Pass uses a badge attached to a student’s backpack, which then communicates with the Z-Pass scanner located on the bus. This system allows the Transportation Department to know when and where each elementary student enters and exits the bus on their assigned route.

North Kansas City Schools offers this this service to parents and/or legal guardians who would like to participate. In accordance with 167.168 RSMo, student participation in the service is not mandatory; therefore parents and/or legal guardians may choose not to participate by opting out of the service.

Parents and/or legal guardians seeking to opt out of the Zonar Z-Pass Student Ridership Program for their elementary-aged children should complete and return the form below to their student’s school office.
