Resources/Textbooks

How do we know which books we need?

Go to: <https://www.bkstr.com/mcckcstore>

Enter your MCC Student ID# or if the system takes too long (it gets bogged down), then you can search by course.

Are we allowed to take notes inside textbooks?

- If it is a workbook, then definitely use it to complete the work. It is considered consumable. But a regular textbook we would prefer you use post its/sticky notes, just like a high school textbook.

Do we pay for our textbooks?

- No, the district has obtained grants and gifts from partnerships to pay for textbooks.

On the first day of class I find out my professor has changed the book or I need a new resource, what do I do?

Schedule

Can we still change our MCC schedule?

- Yes, if absolutely necessary. Classes are filling quickly and if you drop one class, there may not be something that you want to take.
- MCC does not allow students to be added to a class after it has met one time. You can only drop a class, without financial responsibility in the first week, but this could effect your eligibility in a MSHSAA sanctioned activity, if you drop below required credit enrollments.

Are we allowed to take MCC summer school?

- A junior in the program can definitely take classes between their junior year of ECA entering their senior year.

College Credit & High School Credit

How do college hours transfer back to the high school?

- A college class of 1 -3 hours equates to .5 high school credit
- A college class of more than 3 hours, equates to 1 high school credit.

How many hours can I take per semester?

- According to the Missouri Department of Elementary Secondary Education a high school student should be enrolled in no more than 4 credits per semester.

How do I maintain my MSHSAA Eligibility?

- A student must be enrolled and successfully earn 3.5 credits in order to participate in any MSHSAA sanctioned activity.

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Semester vs. Year Long Classes

- All MCC classes are one semester in length. The same work that is expected at the college in a semester, is stretched into a yearlong class at the high school. This means the college classes are quite intense and you will have a lot of studying outside of actual class time.

What is College 100-First Year Seminar?

- Class will be taught online in Blackboard and via Virtual Conferencing. I will provide a schedule. In first semester you earn 1 College hour/.5 credit Elective high school credit and in second semester you earn .5 credit Elective high school credit. This class teaches necessary skills for a successful college experience.

What is College 101- Second Year Seminar?

- Class will be taught online in NKC Canvas and via Virtual Conferencing. I will provide a schedule. You will earn .5 credit Elective high school credit both semesters.

Technology

Most MCC classes will use Zoom for live virtual lectures, but my MacBook doesn't let me download this, what can I do?

- You don't need to download Zoom, you should be able to "Join via the Web" when you are prompted. If you have any questions or concerns, call the NKC HELP desk, tell them you are in the ECA and they will help you with the steps you need to take to be able to access Zoom. Be sure when you "join via the web" to grant access for video and microphone options.

Communication

- All ECA students are MCC students and have an MCC email address. Students should be checking this email daily, as the college will send out campus updates. Many students have found it beneficial to set their MCC email to be pushed to their "phones" in order to not miss out on any important information.
- Professors will communicate via MCC email AND their Blackboard classes.
- Syllabus – all course information – expectations for participation and attendance, grading, communication methods, all pertinent information to the course can be found in the Syllabus. The Syllabus dictates the course. I recommend, if possible download the syllabi for each class and keep handy, to refer to often.

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- Also be sure to check NKC email, as counselors and high school information will be sent to students there.

Transportation

I don't drive what do I need to do in order to participate?

- North Kansas City Schools provided district transportation from your home high school to Maple Woods and back. Depending on your school, you will likely catch the bus at about 7:30 a.m. and then be back in time for 3rd block.
- Due to Covid 19, MCC is remaining in Phase 2, meaning students will not be on the MCC campus. If you are taking face to face classes at your high school in the afternoon, you will ride your normal bus to school in the morning and then go to the library, or another space designated by the high school for you work on your MCC class.
- The MCC campus is NOT open, so you will not be allowed to work at the Student Center.
- If you do not depend on district transportation you can work on your MCC classes in a space that you and your parents decide (home). If you have classes at your high school be sure you arrive on time for them.

Forms

- These forms will need signatures, but a scanned PDF of the signed copy may be submitted.
- 2nd year students will not need to resubmit these forms

Grades

How do I know what my grades are throughout the semester?

- College professors may or may not keep your grades updated in Blackboard.
- You will be asked to "self-report" your grades, if you know them, to Ms. Gilliland throughout the semester, and she will post them in PowerSchool. Be advised these are not official, more just a check in of progress.
- Grades from your official transcript will be posted in PowerSchool when MCC sends them to NKC schools at the end of the semester.
