Teacher's Report (3 minutes) Mrs. Barbara Skelecz and Mr. Cristian Campo

Ms. Barbara-2nd grade bilingual teacher. Ms. Barbara gave thanks to Mr. Moncada for the support that her and the staff are receiving. The teachers are resolving technical issues and other issues that families are facing. Almost all students are attending school online. The teachers are working with individual families who still need assistance. Learning packets are given out to students who cannot be online. The teachers are attending training on COVID-19 issues. RGEC, Engage NM and Taos Behavioral Health are supporting us with our students in need.

Mr. Campo-Bilingual 4th grade. Mr. Moncada is supporting all teachers with the proper training for on-line resources, on-line activities, and other resources to keep students connected. (ie: computers for teachers, hot spots for students, etc.). Teachers are close to the parents and offer personal phone numbers to communicate by text, phone, or email.

Ms. Beth thanks Mr. Campo and Ms. Barbara for helping the students to learn Spanish.

Principal's Report (10 minutes)

Mr. Moncada
Enrollment=400, +38 in pre-k. The staff has worked hard to bring back former
students who left. Employees: In middle school, they tried to hire but are
interviewing again. Former teacher, Rosemary Espinosa has been hired for Pre-K.
Mr. Moncada is reviewing the budget to see if another 1st and 2nd grade teacher can
be hired in order to lower student/teacher ratio. Ms. Liz left and Ms. Fanny is
onboard, Ms. Fanny is fluent in English and Spanish and Mr. Eric Perez is helping
with the transition. Istation testing and IMSSA testing are being administered to 38th grade students in math, reading and Spanish. K-2 only take Istation Math,
Reading and Spanish Reading. All students will be tested by Oct. 23, 2020. Mr.
Moncada thanks Ms. Nuria for learning how to administer the new test, iMSSA.

Mr. Moncada has attended Charter Voice, Charter School Collaboration, Title 3, Professional Development and School safety plan meetings.

CDHA has ordered 36 more ChromeBooks for Pre-K. 225 Chromebooks and HotSpots were distributed to homes. CDHA had a new phone system installed. Virtual power-points were made in order to get to know the staff. A Fire Visit was conducted and 3 finding were noted: HotBox, Sprinkler System Inspection and a light needs to be replaced in a bathroom. The Moss/Adams audit is ongoing. The grant, Achieve Educators Rising: to support new teachers or teachers with alternative licenses has been awarded to the school.

Ms. Melissa and Ms. Weeks conducted Open House last week. Test Security Training was given to the staff. Ms. Roxanna, Ms. Melissa and Mr. Moncada are starting to have virtual meetings with parents on Tuesdays, one at 7:30 and one at 6:00. Thank you to Ms. Roxanna and Ms. Melissa for the idea! The virtual meetings will alternate in the morning and the evening and in English and in Spanish.

There will be a raffle for parents who show up at the meetings. The school is working with delivering food, hotspots, and the new attendance supports. Volleyball club has been cancelled per the Governor's orders but to continue with

their skills with virtual monitoring, each student has received a volleyball to practice at home. Renewal procedures are in place for the Charter. They are being conducted on-line. Water was delivered to every class since kids cannot leave the classroom.

Rick asked if Mr. Saylor is responsible for replacing water faucets or us. Mr. Moncada is paying but will check if Saylor will replace. ChromeBooks for Pre-K will be distributed as soon as they arrive as they will include Child Proof Cases. Pre-K has their own monies to purchase ChromeBooks and covers and will trade them out as they arrive. Will use the new ones for replacements.

B. Approval/Disapproval of amendment to the lease agreement to show increase of \$500 a month for insurance (\$35,500 a month) Mr. Moncada

The bank does not recognize NMPSIA as an insurance carrier for Mr. Saylor so he asked that we pay for his property insurance which is not uncommon to add into the lease. The insurance cost was included in the approved lease agreement. The insurance cost is actually \$505.33 per month per Mr. Saylor for the lease agreement insurance, not \$500, by Francisco Ronquillo asked why we pay 2 insurances. Commercial lease states that we are responsible for the insurance.

Dan Hill looked into it and CDHA is responsible. We had already paid July, August, September and October months separately, so moving forward we will make only one payment of \$35,505.33.

Motion made to approve the amendment to the lease agreement in the amount of \$35,505.33 to include the cost for the commercial insurance on lease by Francisco Ronquillo, 2nd by Roxanna De La Torre, Vote: Unanimous

C. Approval/Disapproval of K-8+ Program and PreK Stipends for Principal Mr. Rick Reichard

The K-8 plus program adds an extra 25 days to the calendar and teachers get compensated for the extra days but Mr. Moncada needs board approval to request this extra pay as a stipend at the daily rate. He also gets a stipend for running the Pre-K program, \$7,500 divided by 2 that he would like to request it be approved. Mr. Moncada spoke with Carla Cano at APS as to how other principals are getting paid. \$12,233.26 daily salary for 25 days.

Motion made to approve K-8 and Pre-K Stipends for Mr. Moncada by Beth Esquivel, 2nd by Francisco Ronquillo Vote: Unanimous

D. Approval/Disapproval of Check Signers Mr. Moncada
Because Dr. Quiñones and Dr. Delgado are no longer with CDHA, we need a new signer for checks. Ms. Julie Weeks and Mr. Francisco Ronquillo have been recommended.

Motion made to approve Francisco Ronquillo and Julie Weeks to sign checks for the school, 2nd by Rich Reichard. Vote: Unanimous

- E. Discussion of the hiring of a family member Mr. Rick Reichard Mayra Moncada, Mr. Moncada's wife was willing to apply for job as Pre-K teacher but Rosemary Espinosa was hired for the job. There is still a 1st grade teaching position that is still available and and possibly a 2nd grade. Mayra is on leave from APS and will need to resign but is willing to take the job if another teacher cannot be found. It is legal for husband/wife to work together.
