Middle School Report for Governing Council

- I. GEAR UP week (September 27-30) was a successful event where students engaged in activities with college research, hearing teacher's educational journey stories and building a culture of engagement and investment centered around forward thinking of their future
- II. Students tested in second monthly formative assessment using Istation platform
 - A. In reading grade 6 increased levels 3-5(scores above 40%tile) from 28% to 40%, grade 7 from 19% to 29%, and grade 8 19% to 25%
 - B. In math grades 7 and 8 decreased students in level 1 (scores below 20%tile)
- III. Middle school students have started using the Read 180 and Math 180 program
 - A. Read 180 is servicing 4 grade 6 students, 7 grade 7 students and 4 grade 8 students
 - B. Math 180 is servicing 15 grade 6 students, 11 grade 7 students and 15 grade 8 students
- IV. Middle school student leaders have been identified to attend the La Cosecha Conference on November 12th; 15 grade 8 students have been identified to attend with two teacher sponsors; registration is currently in process
- V. GEAR UP CEOs have begun planning school wide community service activity, partnering with the New Mexico Ronald McDonald House

- VI. Septembers professional development engaged teachers in professional development to help teachers navigate new NMPED Canvas platform to build professional development plans, learn about the MLSS components, and get the basics of diving into student ISIP data to better service our students
- VII. Professional development for the month of November will be centered around implementation of school-wide student data binders and diving deeper into MLSS
- VIII. The C&I team helped finalize MLSS plan, NMDASH plan and literacy plan for CDHA
- IX. The C&I team instituted an optional "New Teacher Meet and Connect" monthly support for new teachers at CHDA, so far we have held two meetings one focusing on standards based report cards and the other on lesson planning development, next month's focus will be on inputting grades into Synergy platform, per request of teachers
