STARTING A GIFTED REFERRAL TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES

- All gifted referral students will need 6 weeks of tier I data.
- Students in K-2 must be advanced in either/or reading/math or creativity and/or critical thinking
- Students 3-12 must be proficient in either/or reading/math or creativity/critical thinking
- Complete AG 1 and email to your SAT Chair
- Complete B6 and G7
- If the first two questions on the G6 are answered “only English” or “mostly English,” complete the G6, the G7 form is not required.
- Obtain a nursing summary from the nurse-G2
- Obtain parent consent on G6

Tier I

- Whole group instruction starting 1st day of school
- Teacher provides professional teaching strategies (sheltered instruction and differentiated instruction)
- FORMS FOR SAT (R1-Teacher completes 1 strategy, 6 weeks of monitoring and 3 data points)
- R1-Behavior only-1 week of monitoring, every teacher monitors, focus on one behavior-safety being a priority.

Starting SAT Referral Teacher Responsibilities

- Complete and email to SAT Chair
- Request vision and N1
- If EL has E in Synergy, complete R6
- If the 1st two questions on the R6 are answered “only English” or “mostly English, complete the R6, R7, R8, and R9 are not required
- Make sure parents are aware of your concerns PRIOR to the SAT Chair sending out the survey home.

Tier 2

What is Tier 2

- Small group instruction
- Research-based curriculum
- Progress monitoring (1 intervention per area of concern, lasting 8 weeks, with 4 data points.
- Tier 2 never stops until student is placed in special education or SAT stops
- Tier 2 Interventions (small group, 20 minutes daily for elementary,
