EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

The Board of Education recognizes that education cannot be satisfactorily achieved without the coordination and cooperation of all stakeholders within the Hewlett-Woodmere School District. To achieve the highest quality of education, it is essential to evaluate the program as it operates in each school and at each level to ensure the instructional program meets the goals established by the Board of Education. The evaluation process will demonstrate to the community that expenditures and other educational contributions lead to beneficial student outcomes in the form of student achievement.

The purposes of evaluating the instructional programs are to:

1. Indicate instructional strengths and weaknesses;
2. Provide information needed for advanced planning;
3. Provide data for public information;
4. Show the relationship between achievement and the school system's stated goals; and
5. Check on the suitability of the instructional program in terms of community requirements.

The Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee will recommend to the Board of Education improvements in the program based upon the evaluation of the district's program.
