A Message from our Health Department

ILLNESS: Students who have symptoms of respiratory or gastrointestinal infections, such as cough, fever (being 100.4 or above), sore throat, vomiting, or diarrhea, should stay home. Students need to be free from fever, vomiting, and diarrhea for 24 hours without feverreducing medication before returning to school.



The CDC recommends COVID-19 testing for individuals with <u>symptoms of COVID</u>. If an individual tests positive for COVID, the CDC recommendation is that they stay at home for five days **after the first day of symptoms or positive test** and wear a well-fitting mask in public on days 6–10.
