MINUTES

- Mrs. Flaa welcomed the group and asked everyone to share their name, campus/position, or affiliation.
- Mrs. Flaa reviewed the objectives of the meeting, including the purpose and requirements of the DEIC, an overview of parent and family engagement, the continuous improvement process, the 23-24 district improvement summary, a district construction update, and committee feedback.
- Ms. Mulkey shared every district must have a DEIC, and every campus must have a CEIC made up of stakeholders to review educational plans, performance objectives, and instructional programs. Each year, the DEIC will present during a public meeting the performance results of the district as reported on the Texas Academic Performance Report or what is called (TAPR).
- Ms. Mulkey shared that a requirement of districts with at least 40% low socioeconomic status is to have a parent and family engagement policy. All of our campuses meet this threshold; therefore, they each create a policy and a compact. While the compact is a requirement, it is also an opportunity for all stakeholders to work together. The compact requires stakeholders to have ownership in helping students achieve at high levels. An example of a compact from years past is shown as an example.
- Ms. Mulkey shared the District Improvement plan aims to guide the district and campuses in improving the



education for all student groups. The SISD proposed goals were reviewed.

- Mrs. Flaa gave a bond project update to include construction at CCI, the Agricultural Science Center, and renderings of the new high school. The groundbreaking ceremony for the new high school is on October 11th. Updates on additional district projects include turfing the softball and baseball fields and new playground systems at CCI and BES.
- Mrs. Flaa shared tentative meeting dates with the committee (November 9th, February 7th, and April 3rd).
- During questions, Mrs. Flaa shared we are hiring two more police officers and purchasing three police vehicles.
