SENIORS: PLEASE CHECK OUT THESE TIMELY COLLEGE APPLICATION REMINDERS & TIPS!

Your College Counseling Team greatly enjoyed meeting with the Class of 2024 during your social studies class release day this past week. We are thrilled and grateful for the energy and the enthusiasm you are bringing to your college app process. It is just one month until the popular November 1st college application deadline – so here are a few key reminders we reviewed to keep you on track:

TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS ARE UNDERWAY! Come in to review your planned college applications with Ms. Sahagún. She can help review your transcript request for your college(s) and ensure any other documents will be completed for your application. Ms. Sahagún is available on a drop-in, no appointment needed, basis throughout the day (including before school, lunch and after school) to go over what you have submitted. Plan to spend a few minutes with her for each request. Remember, please see Ms. Sahagún *at least two weeks before* your college deadline! **Beat the crowd and the line to see her (which will happen in mid-October!) and come in soon!**

SENIOR THURSDAY DROP-IN DAYS! Stop in with those quick 5-10 minute questions and get answers to keep your application process moving forward. Stuck on a CommonApp question? Needing help to decipher college application deadline dates or what materials are required? Drop In! No appointment needed.
