

Joint Communications from California School Employees Association (CSEA) and Folsom Cordova Unified School District (FCUSD) Negotiations on May 11, 2022

The California School Employees Association (CSEA) and the Folsom Cordova Unified School District met on May 11, 2022, for negotiations. Negotiations included the following:

Design Tech High School Charter Petition Presentation: Assistant Superintendent, Betty Jo Wessinger, provided a presentation to the teams on the Design Tech High School charter school petition. She allowed the CSEA team to discuss the impacts that this program and the loss of 500 high school students would have on staffing and programs at Cordova High School.

Job Descriptions: Twelve (12) proposed job descriptions were brought to the table and discussed. The Teams collectively agreed to revisit five (5) of the job descriptions at a future meeting.

- Food Service Technician
- Lead Financial Accountant

- Adult Education Account

Five (5) job descriptions were reviewed, and the teams mutually agreed to update these positions in the bargaining unit. These job descriptions and the financial impact will be presented for approval at the May 19, 2022, Board meeting.

One (1) job description was mutually agreed to not be a part of the CBU.

Expanded Learning Opportunities: Coordinator of Expanded Learning Programs, Marie Pawlek, gave a presentation to the teams on the upcoming opportunities in the Expanded Learning Opportunities Programs (ELOP). The teams brought up questions that Marie will investigate and bring back to the group. The growth of the program will provide approximately 88 new classified positions.
