RE: School Re-Opening

Dear Dr Koligian,

This is follow up to our discussion. Per CDPH and a forthcoming Health Order update, schools that are already open for in-person instruction may remain open in the purple tier, however schools that have not yet reopened may not reopen for in-person instruction until Sacramento County returns to Red Tier 2 and remains there for two weeks. Campuses that are in the midst of a phased reopening are allowed to continue with their opening, but this does not apply to other campuses within that same school system that have not already begun to reopen. These requirements are outlined by CDPH in [this FAQ](#).

Based on the plans you submitted to Public Health, your date for re-opening was 11/9/2020, and you have scheduled classes for this week. Given this information and the fact that you have already presented the FCUSD re-opening plan for review and had a site visits, I approved for the school campuses that have re-opened to proceed. Please let me know if you have any questions.
