You will program your robots using the LEGO MINDSTORMS Education EV3 Software, which is based on National Instruments LabVIEW, the industry-leading graphical programming language used by scientists and engineers worldwide!

### Filmmaking

This camp teaches the fundamentals of filmmaking utilizing Hollywood-level editing and special effects software. Students will work in teams utilizing green screens and props to bring their ideas to life. On the last day, the students will view each other's films at our own Creator Camp Oscars film festival.
