



Yorkshire Academy Immunization Policy 2020-2021

Immunization Policy

Every student enrolled in Yorkshire Academy shall be immunized against preventable diseases caused by infectious agents by vaccination in accordance with the immunization schedule adopted by the Texas Department of State Health Services. A student who fails to present the required evidence shall not be accepted for enrollment or if enrolled, enrollment will be terminated. The only exception to the foregoing requirement is a **medical exemption** signed by a licensed physician (M.D. or D.O) authorized to practice in the State of Texas on the physician's letterhead, including the physician's license number. *Conscientious objections or waivers, which may be permissible for attendance in public schools, do not qualify as an exemption at Yorkshire Academy.*

Provisional Enrollment

All immunizations should be completed by the first date of attendance in accordance with State law and regulations for vaccination of students. A student may be enrolled provisionally if the student has an immunization record that indicates the student has received at least one dose of each specified age/grade-appropriate vaccine required by this rule and thereafter promptly completes all required vaccinations. Evidence of vaccination completions shall be provided to the school as promptly as possible. A school administrator shall review the immunization status of a provisionally enrolled student every 30 days to ensure continued compliance in completing the required doses of vaccination. If, at the end of the 30-day period, a student has not received a subsequent dose of vaccine, the student is not in compliance and the school shall exclude the student from school attendance until the required dose is administered and proof of immunization has been provided to the school.
