

## Junior Parking Application 2023 - 2024

### **MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVING AND PARKING REGULATIONS**

The privilege of student driving will be extended on a first come basis to all **Juniors**, who meet the following conditions:

1. **Attendance during the School Year:** No more than five (5) unexcused absences  
No more than five (5) unexcused tardies
2. **Discipline during each semester:** No more than four (4) ISS or three (3) OSS

Temporary parking permits may be requested for extenuating/urgent purposes, and can be revoked at any time according to parking availability.

**The following rules apply to all students:**

1. The Pleasant Valley High School registration of a Motor Vehicle Form must be completed, including required information. **Students must provide a copy of a valid driver's license, state vehicle registration card, and insurance identification card.**
2. Each student who registers his/her particular vehicle will be issued a parking tag. **This tag is to be affixed to the passenger side lower corner of the windshield.** Students who fail to display this tag will run the risk of disciplinary consequences but not limited to the following: suspension and/or revocation of parking privileges.
3. All vehicles driven to school by students must be parked in the east parking lot (auditorium side) designated by the Administration. Parking is permitted only in the spaces provided.
4. Cars are not to be moved during the day unless permission is obtained from Administration.
5. If a student changes vehicles during the school year, he/she must report this change to the office.
6. Only students with valid parking permits are allowed to park at school. Students must park the designated vehicle.
7. Possession or distribution of a forged or stolen permit will run the risk of disciplinary consequences but not limited to the following: suspension and/or revocation of parking privileges.
8. Any indication of unsafe, reckless or discourteous driving may run the risk of disciplinary consequences but not limited to the following: suspension and/or revocation of parking privileges.
9. Students are not permitted to sit in cars upon arrival, for any reason. Students are expected to vacate and lock their vehicle upon arrival at school and to report into the building.
10. **Students who park on the school's property without the proper parking tag affixed to the vehicle are subject to the Trespass Laws of the State of Pennsylvania, and the disciplinary consequences of P.V.H.S. Illegal/unauthorized parking will result in towing of the car with the driver responsible for any towing expense.**
11. Speed limits, as posted and other driving laws of the state of Pennsylvania are in effect. **NOTE: The speed limit in parking lots and driveways is 15 MPH.**
12. The school is not responsible for theft or vandalism to automobiles or their contents.
13. Parking off school property, illegally, may result in actions taken by private property owners and NOT the school.
14. **Parking privileges will be suspended for excessive tardies (more than 5 unexcused tardies), absences (no more than 5 unexcused absences) and inappropriate behavior (excessive suspensions).**
15. All vehicles parked on school property are subject to searches by school officials, school police, and other law enforcement agencies. Searches may be conducted as outlined in School Board Policy 226 and 226AR.

The school considers the use of an automobile to be one of the most serious responsibilities assumed by students in the school. Therefore, all rules are expected to be obeyed and will be strictly enforced.

**Any violation of the above regulations may result in:**

1. The loss of the privilege of parking at school will be for the remainder of the school year.
2. Suspension from school for serious or persistent violations
3. Arrest for violations of PA Motor Vehicle Code
