## Adult and children's mental health services



KidsPeace's outpatient mental health clinic in Mount Pocono, PA, now serves adults as well as children. Over the years of treating children and adolescents, we have learned that parents and other caregivers can often benefit from our services as well to improve the overall functioning of the family. The holistic approach at Orchard Behavioral Health allows us to care for people ages 3 to 65 under one roof.

The clinic is structured as an urgent care walk-in model, which allows us to be responsive to immediate needs of the community. This expedites the process of initiating care, avoids long emergency room waits and allows KidsPeace staff to assess the client, stabilize any crisis and make an appropriate level of care recommendation. In turn, it allows emergency rooms to focus their efforts on treating physical injuries rather than mental health concerns.

### Walk-Ins

Walk-in centers are becoming increasingly common for physical health, to relieve the burden on the overtaxed health care system and to provide patients with quick, quality care during times when primary care doctors are not available.

The outpatient mental health clinic works in a similar manner, and provides an opportunity for clients in need of more acute care to be directly admitted to hospitals or other programs. The goal is to make the mental health system easier to navigate.

### Staff

Visitors to the outpatient mental health clinic are initially seen by a master's-level clinician. The staff includes board-certified psychiatrists, CRNPs, outpatient therapists, outpatient case managers and Physician Assistants.
