Divine Child placed last out of five teams in the seasons only CHSL AA Jamboree. Colin Murray, Divine Child's top runner, took his second straight race off and the next top five runners used this meet for a training work out.

Ann Arbor Gabriel Richard has won the last four AA Jamboree over three years. Divine Child who used this meet as a training day to prepare for this weekend's meet at the Otsego Bulldog Invitational.

Gabriel Richard won with 44 points, followed by newcomer, Jackson Lumen Christi with 58 pts. Macomb Lutheran North placed third with 73 pts., edging out Bloomfield Hills Cranbrook who had 78 pts. Divine Child finished last will 96 points. Jackson Lumen Christi appeared also using this meet as a training meet. Neither of their top runners ran anywhere close to their best times this season.

Cranbrooks senior, Solomon Kwartowitz won with a time 16 minutes 28.7 seconds. The next sixth runners were all from either Jackson Lumen Christi (JLC) and Ann Arbor Gabriel Richard (AAGR). Placing second was senior Gannon Shore (JLC) with a 17:12.0; third was senior Sunishthh Singh (AAGR), 17:43.5; fourth was sophomore Gibson Shore (JLC), 17:58.7; fifth was sophomore, Joseph Horn (AAGR), 18:01.4; sixth was freshman Avery Morrow (JLC), 18:04.7; and, seventh was Marek Borgstahl (AAGR), 18:06.0.

Leading the way for Divine Child were junior's Tamer Zahr ( $16^{th}$ ) and Nicholas Nakic ( $17^{th}$ ) with times of 19:08.2 and 19:08.5, respectively. The next five Divine Child runners were: Junior Maximiliano Juarez,  $20^{th}-19:19.5$ ; Freshman Grant Goodwin,  $21^{st}-19:20.6$ ; Senior Ethan Lewis,  $22^{nd}-19:25.2$ ; Senior Charlie Murray,  $27^{th}-19:53.5$ ; and, Senior Robert Modrzejewski,  $28^{th}-19:55.2$ .

The most exciting part of this meet was watching two of our junior varsity athletes, run their personal best. First was sophomore's Alexander Thomas with a 25:18.6 and Matthew Khzouz running a 27:17.0.
