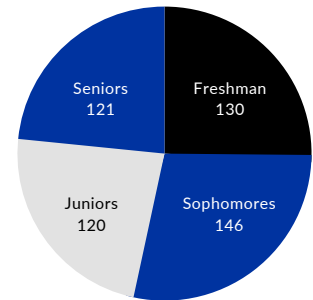

STUDENT SCHEDULE

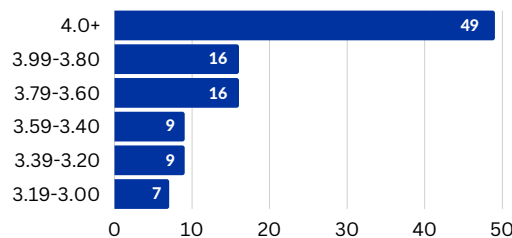

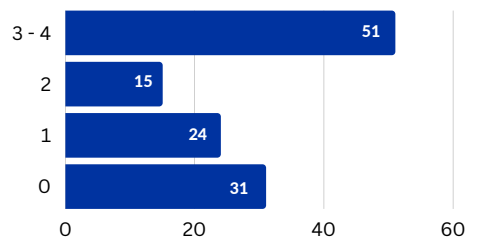
CLASS OF 2023 GPA DISTRIBUTION

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Monte Vista offers two diplomas: an MVCS High School Diploma and an IB Diploma. "F" grades in courses required for graduation must be repeated. F and D grades are recoverable by retaking the course or completing a recovery course.

***MVC Diploma with Honors:** Complete an additional 40 credits above the MVC Diploma requirements in one or more of the following areas: English, Mathematics, Individuals & Societies, Science, DP Visual and Performing Arts, and World Language. Must be a course candidate in a minimum of 1 Higher Level (HL) course and earn a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Extended Essay (EE): All IB diploma candidates will complete an EE for graduation.

‡ Physical Education: This requirement can be met through participation in two seasons of an MVC sanctioned sport.

Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS): All IB diploma candidates will complete an CAS for graduation.

†MVC IB Diploma Additional Requirements: Must take at least three (3) IB Standard Level courses and three (3) IB Higher Level courses and complete the IB Diploma Program's CORE (CAS, EE, TOK).

***Variable:** If a student elects to replace the VPA course with another subject, she/he will only need 10 credits in VPA.

Disclaimer: Receiving the MVC IB Diploma indicates a student has met all of the requirements of the IB issued diploma. Although a student has met these requirements, receiving the IB diploma from IB is contingent on meeting the IB Diploma test score requirements.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

The Diploma Program (DP) provides students in grades 11-12 a set of curriculum in which they apply the inquiry skills developed in the MYP to more advanced courses. While everyone in grades 11-12 will take DP courses, they will have the option to pursue Higher Level (HL) or Standard Level (SL) versions, in addition to Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS), and Extended Essay (EE). Students pursuing an IB diploma (as opposed to a standard MVC diploma) will take 3 HL & 3 SL courses

The Middle Years Program (MYP) provides students in grades 6-10 an inquiry-based learning framework. Eight core subjects are covered throughout the five years of the MYP, with the Personal Project as a capstone in 10th grade.

PERSONAL PROJECT

The personal project is completed at the end of 10th grade. It is a culminating experience in which students apply their approaches to learning skills to complete an extended, self-directed piece of work. This required component provides opportunities for creative and truly personal demonstrations of learning. Completion of the project is reflected on the transcript with credit or no credit depending on completion.

IB EXAMS

All students are allowed to take IB external Assessments for all HL courses and IB Diploma candidates will take External Assessments for all SL and HL courses.

HL & HONORS CLASSES

MVC encourages balance in classes throughout high school. Students are asked to take no more than 3 HL courses (they may appeal to take up to 4 but it is highly discouraged). Students taking HL courses are required to take the External Assessment.
