Subject: Safety Programs

Precautions will be taken to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present on district property or at school-sponsored events.

The practice of safety will also be considered an integral part of the instructional program through fire prevention, emergency procedures and drills, driver education, and traffic and pedestrian safety. This includes the prescribed amount of fire and arson prevention training as per state regulation.

Each principal will be responsible for the implementation and supervision of a safety program for his/her school.

General areas of emphasis in the safety program will include, but not be limited to, in-service training for plant inspection, fire prevention, accident record-keeping, driver and vehicle safety programs, emergency procedures and drills, and traffic safety problems relevant to students, employees and the community.
